

HOCKEY ALBERTA – ZONE 4 – BOUNDARY PROJECT

Member Association: **Thorsby**

Thorsby's boundaries are as follows:

North Boundary

Commencing at a point where the North Saskatchewan River intersects between Section 30, Township 50, Range 27, W4M and Section 25, Township 50, Range 28, W4M, proceed west along the south banks of the North Saskatchewan River until it intersects at a point between Sections 34 and 35, Township 50, range 2, W5M.

East Boundary

Commencing at a point where the North Saskatchewan River intersects between Section 30, Township 50, Range 27, W4M and Section 25, Township 50, Range 28, W4M, proceed south to the southeast corner Section 25, Township 49, Range 28, W4M proceed east 1 section to the Southeast corner of Section 30, Township 49, Range 27, W4M, proceed south to the southeast corner of Section 6, Township 47, Range 27, W4M.

South Boundary

Commencing at Section 6, Township 47, Range 27, W4M, proceed west along the north boundary of the Pigeon Lake Indian Reserve No 138A until it intersects Pigeon Lake of the south boundary of Section 2, Township 47, Range 28, W4M, the proceed in a northwest direction along the shore of the Pigeon Lake to the point where it intersects between Sections 19 and 30, township 47, Range 1, W5M, then proceed in a straight line west to the southeast corner of Section 26, township 47, Range 2, W5M.

West Boundary

Commencing at the southeast corner of Section 26, township 47, Range 2, W5M, proceed north to the Southeast corner of Section 14, Township 49, Range 2, W5M, proceed west one section, to the southeast corner of Section 15, Township 49, Range 2, W5M, proceed north to a point where the North Saskatchewan River intersects between Sections 34 and 35, Township 50, Range 2, W5M.

The above boundaries are based on documents on file:

North Boundary – Original Proposal, have nothing signed to differ from this.

East Boundary – signed in October 1999 by Thorsby President, Kelly Peck and Calmar President Bradley Truitt.

South Boundary – signed September 1999 by Thorsby President Kelly Peck, Wetaskiwin President Dave Luke and Hobbema Administrator Debra Buffalo.

West Boundary – signed in October 1999 by Thorsby President, Kelly Peck and Warburg President Ron Smith.
